## 2010 Registration Days Are Almost Here!

**RETURNING PLAYERS – you may submit your registration materials by mail or at the registration day of your choice (listed above).**

Please mail your registration form, medical waiver form, and a check made out to Gray Little League for your registration fee to Gray Little League PO Box 1236 Gray, ME 04039. **The registration deadline is March 1, 2010. Players registering after March 1<sup>st</sup> will be placed on a space available basis. T-Ball	\$40
Minor and Major Baseball and Softball	\$70
Junior Softball	\$100

**T-ball is for boys and girls ages 5-6.** Players must be 5 by April 30, 2010. Players hit a rubberized ball off a rubber tee.

**Minor League Baseball and Minor League Softball are for players aged 6-11.** Females may play baseball or softball. Baseball players must be 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, or 11 on April 30, 2010. Softball players must be 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, or 11 on December 31, 2009. Players who are 9, 10, or 11 may assess to play at the Major league level if they have played at least one year at the Minor League level. Players playing Minor League baseball have the option of playing coach pitch baseball or assessing for player pitch baseball.

**Major League Baseball and Softball are for players aged 9-12.** Females may play baseball or softball. Baseball players must be 9, 10, 11, or 12 on April 30, 2010. Softball players must be 9, 10, 11, or 12 on December 31, 2009.

**Junior League Softball is for females aged 13-14.** Players must be 13 or 14 on December 31, 2009.

**Please bring your glove and wear sneakers (no cleats)**

Softball	Saturday, March 20 <sup>th</sup> from 9 AM to Noon
Major Baseball	Saturday, March 27 <sup>th</sup> from 9 AM to Noon
Minor Baseball	Saturday, March 27 <sup>th</sup> from 1 PM to 3 PM

**If your child is registered for T-ball they do not need to attend assessments. Their coach will be in touch with you regarding the first practice.**

**Players wishing to move into a new division (example – from T-ball to Minors, from Minor coach pitch to Minor play pitch, and from Minors to Majors MUST attend assessments). Players wishing to play in the same division as last year DO NOT need to attend assessments. Players wishing to play Junior Softball will be contacted by the coach with more information about an assessment date and time.**
